Music	25/01/2021	12/02/2021	Programme note based on what will be their practical performance.
Home Economics	22/02/2021	12/03/2021	This is directly linked to the practical food skills exam. Students will use the design brief process to demonstrate their skills and knowledge in the researching and planning of a food literacy skills task. The tasks might include options from the following areas- healthy family meals; healthy homemade alternative to a takeaway meal; a diet-related disease.
Art Part 1	07/09/2020	20/11/2020	Students choose one scenario from a list issued by NCCA and SEC and are required to realise two artworks through the two strands not undertaken as part of CBA 1.
Art Part 2	06/01/2021	21/05/2021	Students use feedback and advice to develop two finished piece.
English	05/10/2020	23/10/2020	Students prepare an oral presentation of three minutes on a topic of interest to them. This will be completed over a three week period and then presented to their year group.
French	09/11/2020	13/11/2020	Students must present the CBA presentation they prepared in 2nd Year before schools closed. This is followed by oral questions by the teacher.
German	09/11/2020	13/11/2020	Students must present the CBA presentation they prepared in 2nd Year before schools closed. This is followed by oral questions by the teacher.

History	06/01/2021	27/01/2021	Students submit a project based around the theme "The Past in My Place". Students pick an aspect of local history that they would like to further research / investigate. Students' projects can take a variety of formats such as PowerPoint, poster, scrapbook etc. Students do not present this project, it will be handed up directly to the teacher.
Irish	22/02/2021	12/03/2021	The Communicative task is a 3-4 minute oral task, recorded for the purpose of assessment. This can be in the form of a presentation, role play or interview (alone or in a group).
